Novo Nordisk International Talent Program

- A scholarship programme set up to support student mobility between UCPH and IARU-partners in a range of select academic fields
- Recognizing the immense talent within the IARU group and the high quality of education



September 2015



History

- UCPH has a longstanding collaborative relationship with the Danish healthcare company Novo Nordisk (Novo)
- Goal: to support mobility of talent by setting aside stipends to a select group of students pertaining to metabolism, insulin, hemoglobin and obesity
- Agreement was signed summer 2015
- Summer/Autumn 2015:
First in- and outbound students to receive scholarships

Criteria for allocation of scholarships

To be eligible to apply, students are required to

- be enrolled in a programme at a IARU university
- apply for admission to UCPH as an exchange -or guest student for a semester or short term programme
- study at **third year bachelor** or master's level while at UCPH in one of the following programmes:

Bioinformatics, Biochemistry, Biology, Biology-Biotechnology, Public Health, Food Innovation and Health, Global Health, Human Nutrition, Human Biology, Human Physiology, Immunology, Health Informatics, Chemistry, Medicine, Medicine and Technology, Molecular Biomedicine, Nanoscience and Pharmaceutical Sciences.



The Scholarship

The scholarship may be spent towards

- tuition fees
- travel costs
- insurance
- and other expenses in connection with studying at UCPH

The scholarship will typically amount to approx. EURO € 1,200/month.

Depending on the costs and length of studies at UCPH, it may increase up to EURO € 26,000 in total.
