Attended by reps from all four institutions (NUS, Berkeley, Cambridge, UTokyo)


Joined by NUS Centre for Development of Teaching and Learning, and Centre for Instructional Technology

## STUDENT NUMBERS

81 students registered for Cycle 2

4 to 5 students across institutions were grouped around cases of fragile states (2 Asia cases, 4 Africa cases, 2 Middle East cases)

Larger group from UTokyo: internationally diverse and of high quality



## DESIGNATED COLLABORATION PERIOD (6 OCT – 17 NOV)

- | Clearly defined period for peer-to-peer learning & student engagement
- | **6-week period** when all institutions will be in-semester
- | Arose from need to carefully scaffold **cross-institutional** and **cross-cultural learning environment** for students
- | Beginning with “ice-breaker” sessions for students to meet with each other and assigned instructor; as well as video recorded introductions by all students

## POST COURSE EVALUATION & MEETING (UPCOMING)

- | Instructors agree on the importance of a **post course evaluation** and **an instructors’ meeting/workshop**.
- | Funding requested (US\$4,300) for:
  - | Cover work of a part time “research assistant” who would coordinate collaboration period across institutions and collate end of course survey for analysis of student learning (US\$1,600)
  - | Organization of post-course workshop to review survey findings and make adjustments for 3<sup>rd</sup> run (US\$2,700)
