### Airplane

If coming from abroad, the easiest way to travel to Yale University is by air. For international travel, the best option is JFK in New York (approximately 1 ½ from New Haven). Bradley (BDL) does have international travel through Dublin only. If you are flying Domestically, Bradley (BDL) is your best option (approximately 50 minutes from New Haven). Tweed New Haven can only be done by connecting in Philadelphia (on a turboprop). Tweed is located about 15 minutes from New Haven.

### **Options from Bradley Bradford International Airport:**

- Taxi Service: Approximately \$100 per cab

### **Options from JFK International Airport/Newark Liberty International Airport:**

- Taxi Service: Approximately \$180 per cab
- Shuttle Service: \$67 one way per person: <http://ctlimo.com/airport-shuttle-service>

### **Options from the Tweed New Haven Airport:**

- Taxi Service: Approximately \$15 per cab

**Train:**

If traveling from within the United States, it is convenient to take a train to New Haven Union Station, minutes from Yale's campus.

- [Metro-North Railways](#) (800.638.7647) offers frequent train service between New Haven and New York City.
- [Amtrak](#) (800.872.7245) provides train service to New Haven from Vermont, Providence, Boston, and Washington DC.

Once you reach New Haven Union Station, we suggest that you use a local taxi service to reach campus. There is a taxi stand at the station; a taxi ride costs approximately \$10. Alternatively, local shuttles and bus services are also available for travel between Union Station and Yale.

There is a free weekday shuttle from New Haven Train Station to Yale. The Union Station shuttle connects the New Haven Green, various downtown locations, parking, and Union Station—every 20 minutes: <https://www.cttransit.com/services/union-station-shuttle-new-haven>.
